I pour a little piece of myself into everything that I make. I create for myself, but when others get enjoyment out of my work, it makes it that much better.

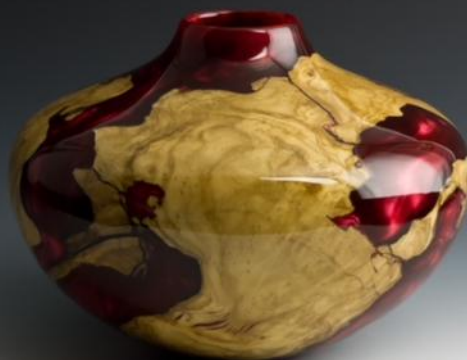

CA finishing of vessels and other forms can be durable, quick, and with a little practice, an easy finish to apply.

We will discuss: safety considerations and equipment when applying a CA finish, the size and type of vessels to which this finish can be applied, the archival considerations of the finish, and materials needed for the successful application of the CA finish.

I will demonstrate the application, sanding, polishing, and bottom finishing techniques needed to successfully finish a vessel.
