- Threading Acorns Made Easy - DEMO

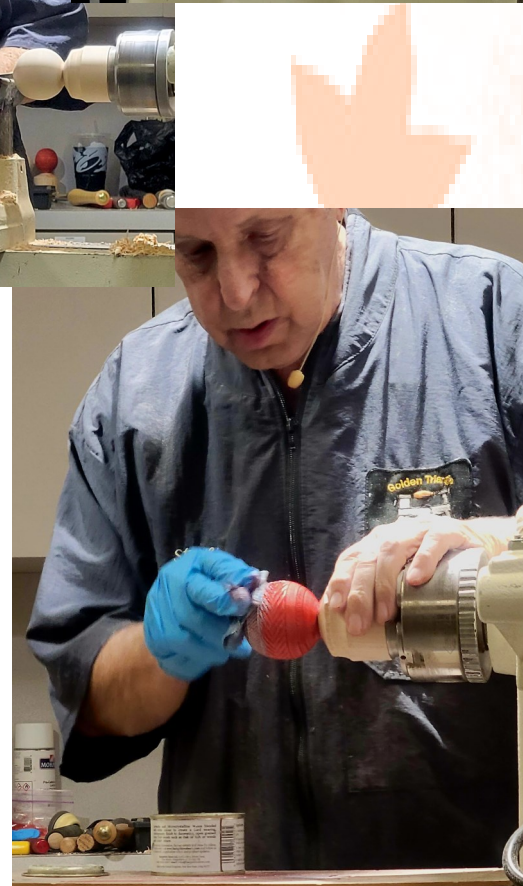
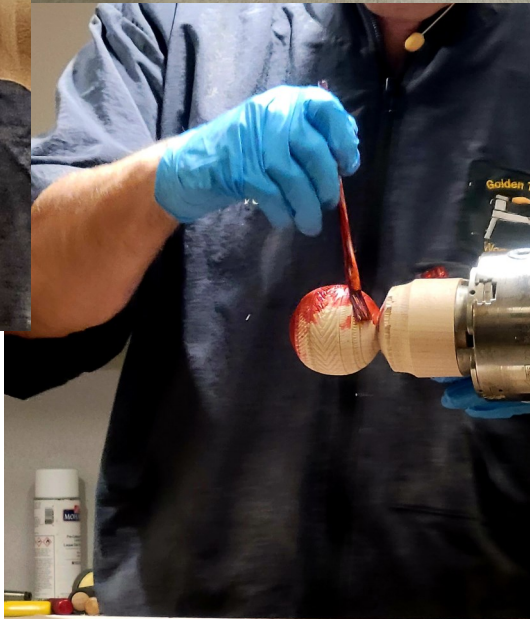

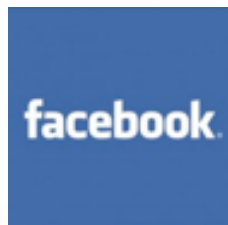
